

# NOTES FOR SUNDAY SERMON

29 SEPTEMBER 2023

**Sermon title** : Sola Christus

## **1. The cross was satisfaction** (Satisfy God's offence)

"Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us" (Galatians 3:13)

"Even the Son of man did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45)

## **2. The cross was sacrifice** (Satisfy God's wrath)

"He (Jesus) is the atoning sacrifice for our sins" (1 John 2:2)

"This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins" (1 John 4:10)

"This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins." (1 John 4:10)

## **3. The cross was substitution**

This substitution in simple terms means that "Christ got what we deserved (on the cross) and we got what Christ deserved as a sinless, innocent, Son of God".

Jesus bore the punishment for our sin in our place (substitute).

"For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ." (2 Corinthians 5:21)
